Nestled in the picturesque landscapes of **Stevens County, Washington**, Deer Lake is a **pristine freshwater retreat** located just **35 miles north of Spokane** and **5 miles from Loon Lake**. With its **crystalclear waters, abundant wildlife, and vibrant community**, the lake offers the perfect escape for outdoor enthusiasts, vacationers, and year-round residents alike.

Deer Lake at a Glance

- Size & Depth: Spanning 1,150 acres, with a maximum depth of 75 feet and an average depth of 52 feet.
- Shoreline & Elevation: The lake features 8.8 miles of shoreline and sits at 2,485.5 feet when full, with a seasonal depth variation of 2.5 feet.
- Water Clarity & Climate: Renowned for its deep, clean water, visibility reaches 25 feet on average. The region averages 50 inches of snowfall annually.
- Infrastructure: Thanks to proactive community efforts, the lake has a sewer and water system encircling its shores.
- Residency: A mix of year-round and vacation homes, with an average resident age of 50 years old. There are approximately 450 waterfront lots.
- Access & Amenities:
 - The main road does not fully encircle the lake, but access points exist on the southeast and west sides.
 - **One private resort** is open to the public, along with various vacation rentals.

Outdoor Activities & Wildlife

Whether you seek adventure or relaxation, Deer Lake offers an abundance of activities:

Fishing – Catch bass (large and smallmouth), rainbow trout, brook trout, crappie, catfish, perch, mackinaw, and sunfish. The kokanee (silvers) population is dwindling due to the discontinuation of stocking.

Boating & Swimming – Enjoy the deep, refreshing waters for kayaking, paddleboarding, waterskiing, or a peaceful swim.

Hiking & Wildlife Viewing – Explore the 750-acre wildlife refuge on N. Deer Lake Rd.

Nature & Birdwatching – Spot bald eagles, ospreys, ducks, and migrating birds, alongside native deer, moose, black bears, bobcats, and cougars.

The surrounding forests are rich with **native pines**, **tamarack**, **and cedar trees**, adding to the breathtaking scenery.
